Alumni Parking

We have a limited number of parking spaces available in College, with no daytime or overnight parking without prior permission from the Head Porter, [Kevin Cash](#). On weekends, parking is available in the Hobson Street car park on a first come, first served basis.

Once you arrive, please use the intercom to connect to the Porters' Lodge, who will grant access.

Please note that there is a one-way system in operation, preventing direct access to St Andrew's Street from Regent Street: private vehicles heading North up Regent Street are directed right into Park Terrace, left into Parkside / Drummer Street and then left again into Emmanuel Street. At the end of Emmanuel Street, turn right into St Andrew's Street and Hobson's Street for the College.

Please also note that Hobson's Street is one-way, with no entry permitted from the King Street end, so it is not possible to access the College car park from King Street. Satellite navigation systems are not always aware of this restriction.

Alternatives

There are several [Park and Ride](#) sites located outside the city centre with bus connections to Drummer Street Bus Station, adjacent to the College, and we would suggest these in terms of their cost-effectiveness and ease of use.

Additionally, there are various city centre car parks available, with the closest to College being the Grand Arcade. Further details including parking charges can be found on the [City Council's website](#).

You will find a number of signs around College with directions to commonly-accessed buildings and areas, and here is a [representational map showing the layout of the College](#), with staircases and public rooms identified.

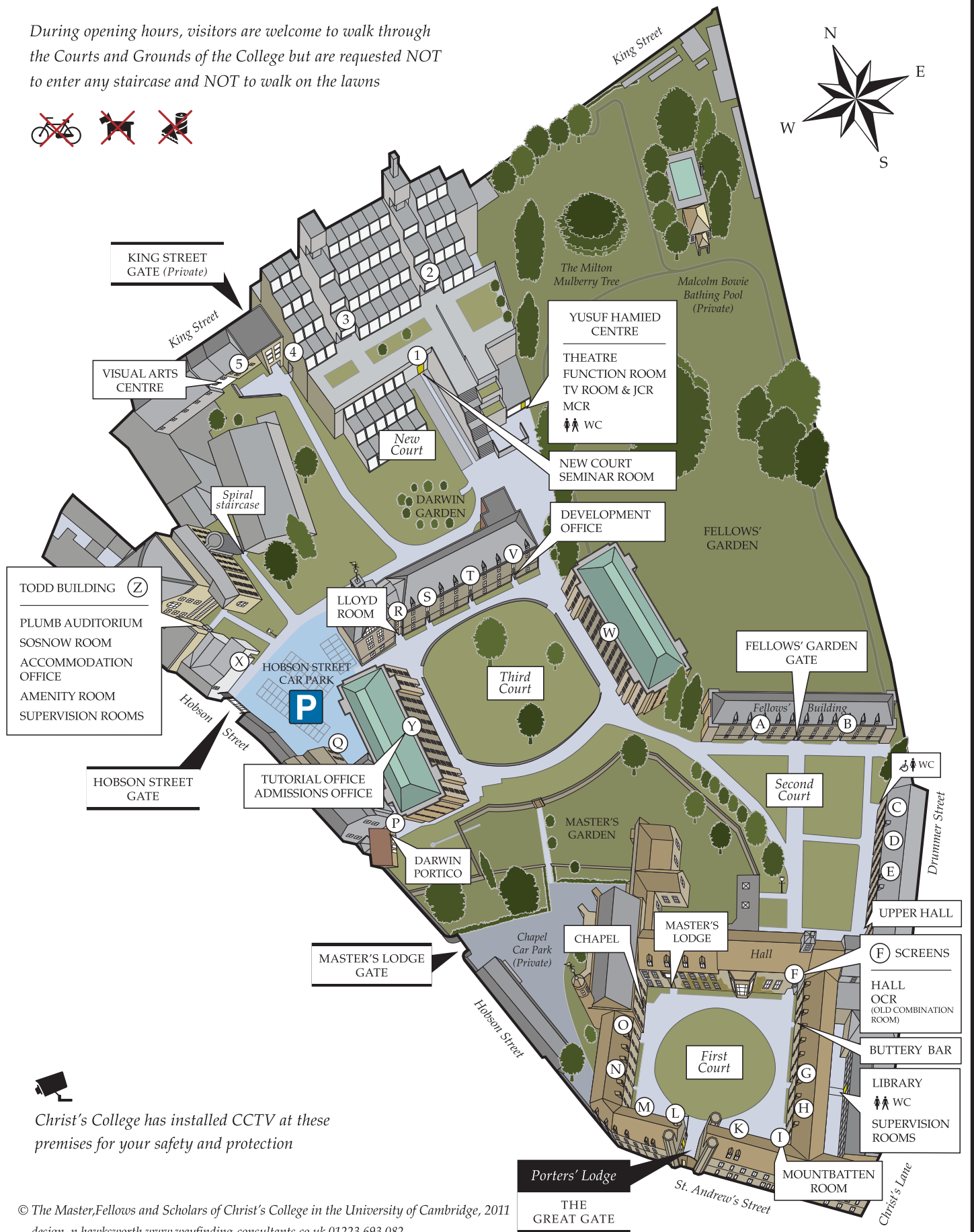
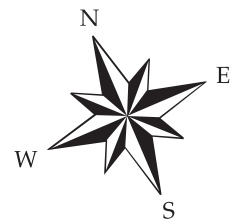


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College Map
